Knowing Jay's love of football and her goal to see him on the field, Ms. Mault contacted Bath High School Principal Rick Gross. Principal Gross discussed the matter with Bath Athletic Director, Rich Dackin, who gave the final approval. Ms. Mault then coordinated efforts to make sure that, rain or shine, Jay will be on the sideline Friday night.
